1. Eatzi's Market & Bakery

Want to eat at home without cooking? Pick up everything at Eatzi's. Order ahead from an extensive menu of appetizers (bacon-mushroom empanadas, mini crab cakes), entrees (roasted turkey, Chateaubriand of beef with port wine demi glace), sides (gruyere and spinach gratin, cornbread stuffing), and desserts (apple pie, buche de Noel) that can be picked up on Christmas Eve. Orders must be placed by phone or in person by December 23, and can be picked up on Christmas Eve. Eatzi's will be closed on December 25.
