A whole new Share takeout for two with your valentine

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Planning to celebrate Valentine's Day with your honey at home this year? We've got you covered with our roundup of romantic takeout options for two. Most specials are offered Feb. 14, but some restaurants are offering deals throughout Valentine's weekend.

AL BERNAT'S has created a cold-prepped, ready-to-heat à la carte menu with entrees like 16-ounce chateaubriand and 6-ounce lobster tail, sides for two such as whipped sweet potatoes and lobster risotto, and sweet treats like peanut butter chocolate banana cream pie and apple cobbler. Sides are \$10.50-\$28.75, and entrees are \$48-\$110. The Premium Osetra Caviar Package is \$225 and comes with a glass dish with crushed ice and a mother of pearl spoon. Order cold-prepped meals by Feb. 8 at 6 p.m. for pickup Feb. 14 from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Orders from the regular menu must be placed 24 hours in advance for pickup Feb. 12-14. Call to order. ASIAN MINT offers a takeout brunch for two that includes bacon fried rice with a Thai fried egg, mee krob (sweet crispy noodles), chocolate mousse crepes and a French Kiss cocktail kit that comes with Chambord liqueur and a bottle of sparkling wine. \$129. Order by Feb. 11 for pickup Feb. 14. The restaurant is not open for dine-in. Four locations in Dallas and Richardson. asianmint.com/valentine.

BLUE MESA has a to-go pack for two available Feb. 12-14 that includes corn griddle cakes with barbecue pork and pickled onion, Southwest Caesar salad, red chile beef tenderloin, shrimp and crab enchiladas with chipotle cream and mango salsa, loaded mashed potatoes,

grilled vegetables and chocolate-dipped strawberries. \$100; delivery is \$6.99. Open for dine-in brunch Feb. 14. Locations in Addison, Fort Worth and Plano. bluemesagrill.com.

BRIO ITALIAN GRILLE has a prix fixe special available Feb. 12-14 for takeout and dine-in with a choice of two entrees: Romano-crusted Chilean sea bass served with roasted fingerling potatoes, spinach, tomatoes and lobster butter sauce; or three 2-ounce beef medallions and grilled shrimp with black pepper cream sauce served with mashed potatoes and asparagus.
