The gourmet-to-go market is now taking orders online for both Easter and Passover menu items. Easter menu highlights included pineapple glazed ham, sweet and sour brisket, rainbow carrots with brown sugar and fennel, and hot cross buns. Passover selections range from traditional matzo ball soup to lavender-glazed turkey breast. Orders should be placed by April 3, and all items will also be available for purchase on Easter Sunday while they last.
