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Full plates and hearts for Mother's Day

Treat Mom to a meal, gift boxes and sweets

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Celebrate your favorite moms this Mother's Day by treating them to a special lunch at home or taking them out for a meal at one of these Dallas-area restaurants on May 9. Our roundup has something for just about everyone, including brunch and bubbly, multi-course menus and a traditional tea time. Reservations are strongly encouraged at most restaurants.

ALBIERNAT'S is open for brunch and dinner on May 9. Brunch menu items include strawberry topped pancakes, brioche French toast, crabcake Benedict, lobster scramble and garlic cheese grills. Dinner dishes include Dad's grilled pear salad, Chilean sea bass, chicken Parmesan and an 8-ounce filet mignon. Vegan items such as grilled portobello enchiladas and butternut squash macaroni and cheese are also on the menu. Dessert items include coconut cream pie, Texas pecan pie and tiramisu. ASIAN MINT'S Thai Mother's Day Meal Kit feeds four people for \$119. The takeout package includes edamame, Asian noodle salad, shrimp and chicken basil with jasmine rice, chocolate flourless cake and a pineapple mimosa kit with Novocento sparkling wine. BLUE MESA GRILL offers a to-go family pack that serves four people for \$70. The brunch package includes migas, breakfast potatoes, biscuits and sausage gravy, build-your-own tacos with beef brisket, barbecue pork, tomatillo chicken, flour tortillas and toppings, picana slaw, smoky black beans, coconut lime rice, sweet corn

cake; cheese enchiladas; and French toast breakfast bread pudding with cayote sauce. The dine-in brunch is \$28 per person and includes options from made-to-order stations including Belgian waffles with berries and whipped cream, chicken and waffles, and omelets; a carving station with brisket, red chile salmon and street tacos; and favorites like Southwest macaroni and cheese and chimayo market corn. Order by May 6 for pickup May 8 all day or May 9 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Three locations in Addison, Fort Worth and Plano. blumesasgrill.com.

BONEFISH GRILL has family bundles to go starting at \$29.99 that include salad, fresh bread and pesto, house-baked cookies, and entrees like Bang Bang shrimp tacos, grilled salmon, grilled mahi-mahi and Lily's Chicken topped with goat cheese, artichoke hearts, sautéed spinach and lemon basil butter sauce. Specialties available for takeout and dine-in include the Rockefeller Butterfish dish (Alaskan black cod topped with creamy spinach and jumbo lump crab), a 7-ounce sirloin served with five jumbo shrimp, and Key lime cake

(vanilla citrus cake layered with Key lime frosting, topped with coconut). Pair your dine-in meal with a crushed pineapple martini made with Malibu rum, St. Germain Elderflower Liqueur and fresh pineapple. Prices vary. 1910 E. Stacy Road, Allen, 1201 E. CBD PROVISIONS offers dine-in brunch from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. with specials like the crab Benedict (\$26) with poached eggs, king crab, English peas and bearnaise; bread pudding French toast (\$14) with strawberries, St. Germain and clotted sweet cream; a bloody mary (\$14) with candied bacon, pickled shrimp, pickled green beans, cocktail onions, Castelvetro olives and celery; and the Bellini Bomb drink (\$12), a peach-infused ice sphere topped with fruit with a choice of rosé or prosecco. 1530 Main St., Dallas. cbdprovisions.com.

COMMISSARY offers packages and a la carte items to go that include selections like the French toast breakfast kit that comes with

berry compote, spiced whipped mascarpone cream, a dozen eggs, sausage and bacon, quiche Lorraine made with bacon, Swiss cheese and onion; a Lox Box that includes five bagels, fresh dill, lemon, capers, red onion and two schmears, a mimosa kit with a bottle of prosecco, orange juice, mango nectar and strawberry peach juice; and raspberry cream macarons. \$15-\$170.
