Eatzi's offerings will include orange bourbon vanilla glazed ham, oven-roasted turkey breast, chipotle bacon glazed turkey legs and Rosewood Ranch smoked wagyu prime rib roast. For sides, choose from the traditional fare of butter-whipped potatoes, caramel and brown sugar smashed sweet potatoes with marshmallows and pecans, macaroni and cheese, green bean casserole or cranberry Brussels sprouts. And of course, don't forget your carbs and desserts such as cornbread or sausage stuffing, dinner rolls and pumpkin or pecan pie. The last day to place online orders is Tuesday, Nov. 22. Orders can be picked up between Thursday, Nov. 17 and Wednesday, Nov. 23. Items are available in all markets beginning Thursday, Nov. 17.
