

Order now for Christmas, Hanukkah pickup

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Looking for a place to order food ahead of time for Christmas or Hanukkah in North Texas? These restaurants are accepting orders for pickup and takeout ahead of the holidays. Many spots in Dallas-Fort Worth are offering special family meals and seasonal desserts alongside their regular a la carte menus. Most require orders to be made ahead of time, so plan accordingly. A few allow for more last-minute orders.

BBBOP Two catering packages priced at \$70 are available from the Korean restaurant. Serving three to four people, both packages include mandarin orange and peanut salad, veggie poststickers, rice, a gallon of tea and a choice of fried chicken or beef bulgogi with mushrooms and onions.

BLUE MESA GRILL Lean into a start-to-finish dining experience with Blue Mesa's holiday dinner menu, priced at \$35 per person. The meal includes beef tenderloin chimichurri, turkey breast, cornbread stuffing, cranberry-jalapeno relish, loaded mashed potatoes, garlic-basil green beans, corn, Southwest Caesar salad and desserts such as pumpkin cheesecake cups, chocolate fudge brownies, sopapilla cheesecake and chocolate chunk cookies. Blue Mesa also offers a Cocktail Time menu for \$22 per person with an assortment of appetizers, such as jalapeno sausage puffs, crab and shrimp cakes, spinach-artichoke dip with grilled bread and chocolate fudge brownie bites. Both menus include corn and sweet potato chips and two salsas.

ham, smoked Gouda mac and cheese, Brussels sprout salad, pumpkin spice latte pie and rye whiskey pecan pie. If those cocktail kits caught your eye, think about mixing up pomegranate margaritas, espresso martinis, booze-infused peppermint mochas or the Triple Dog Pear You (spiced pear, pisco, Champagne and apple foam) with help from Rye or its sister Apothecary.
