

It's time to get chile. Where to find Hatch chiles in Fort Worth

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The Hatch green chile has arrived in Fort Worth.

Every year there are a blissful six to eight weeks when [Hatch chile peppers are in season](#). It usually takes place from the end of July to September. Texans recognize five seasons: summer, spring, fall, winter and Hatch chile season.

The pepper, hailing from the Hatch Valley in New Mexico, can be as mild as a poblano or as hot as a jalapeño, [according to the Scoville pepper heat scale](#). They get their smokey and bold flavor from long, hot summer days and cool nights in the valley.

Tons of truckloads arrive at Texas grocers and restaurants, ready to be roasted and eaten in enchiladas, queso, tamales and even margaritas.
